Students learn the basic disassembly and reassembly process in one session.

Five weekly 3-hour sessions

Students learn how to disassemble, reassemble, install software and perform maintenance tasks on their computer in five sessions.

Ten weekly 2-hour sessions

Students learn to disassemble, reassemble their computer, install software, perform maintenance tasks, install shareware software, write simple programs or install & play games, and use a word processor in ten sessions.



Program costs may be covered by the participants or by the sponsoring organization or any combination of both!
